GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The APFS catalogues list the Forms, Air Publications (APs), Microfiches (FAPs), Joint Service Publications (JSPs), Air Diagrams (ADs), Pamphlets, Posters and other miscellaneous items that are stocked by APFS. They consist of four separately amended books:

AP 113 Book 1 — Forms

AP 113 Book 2 — Uncoded APs and ADs, JSPs, Inventories, Pamphlets, Posters, etc

AP 113 Book 3 — Uncoded Technical APs and ADs (Obsolescent)

AP 100Z-0101 — Coded Technical APs, FAPs, and ADs (This AP)

The code group notes in AP 100Z-0101 are based on AP 100Z-0001 (Air Technical Publications Referencing System. Coding Lists and Procedures). APs and ADs not stocked by APFS because they have been produced mainly or exclusively for the Royal Navy are usually listed only in AP 100Z-0201 (RN Catalogue of Air Publications and Air Diagrams) but are issued nevertheless by APFS to recognized customers.

2. The procedures for demanding, recording and maintaining items issued by APFS are contained in AP 113A (Regulations for the Supply and Maintenance of Publications and Forms).

3. Information affecting the contents of AP 100Z-0101 and AP 113 Books 1 to 3 is contained in the APFS Newsletter, which is normally issued weekly. RAF Forms 3113 may be used to record this information pending its incorporation in the catalogues by means of Amendment List action; it is suggested that an RAF Form 3113 be placed at the end of each section or code group. It is also suggested that the sections or code groups be distinguished by suitably annotated standard marker cards.

4. Holders of the catalogues are invited to notify APFS of errors, omissions and items overdue for deletion.
