SCALE OF AIRCRAFT SERVICING TURN ROUND SPARES

NOTE 1 Aircraft Servicing Turn Round Spares are Class A and B items of equipment which require assembly, Servicing or functional testing before being fitted to an aircraft. This scale is the authority for specific quantities of these items to be held forward of the supply squadron as "Articles in use" in the appropriate Specialist Servicing Bay to permit the immediate repair or replacement of components unserviceable in use.

NOTE 2 Main stock holdings to support scaled quantities of Turn Round Spares should be based on quantities issued against Ministry of Defence tasks in excess of Turn Round Spares quantities and thereafter on consumption.

NOTE 3 Columns 7 to 9 detail scaled quantities against aircraft AE's. Although proportionate increases or decreases may be made to cater for greater or lesser AE's, holdings should be restricted to the minimum consistent with efficient servicing.

NOTE 4 Suggested amendments to these scales should be forwarded by Command Headquarters or equivalent authorities, together with their comments, to SSMW(SSF)CSDE, (RAF) Swanton Morley, copy to SM48 A5(RAF).
