#### Introduction

This chapter contains a description of the various instruments installed in this aircraft, together with the necessary servicing information required to maintain the installation in an efficient condition. The chapter is divided into a number of self-contained groups of information, beginning with a general information group covering the instrument installation as a whole and embodying installation details, general servicing, location of equipment and the removal of the instrument panels. The

remaining groups each appertain to a particular collection of instruments as listed above. Each group embodies a description of the installation of the instruments concerned, including the necessary servicing information and wiring diagrams of the electrically operated instruments. For a detailed description on the standard components employed, reference should be made to the appropriate Air Publications quoted in the following groups.

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
