This modification introduces 2 strips of reflective tape of improved performance as an aid to night location, to be applied to all aircrew helmets to supersede Tape Reflective (32B/1250510). The pattern to be used is laid down in the relevant Air Publication.

Because in some helmet usage, conspicuity may not be required, embodiment of this modification may be waived at MOD Navy or Army Department or RAF Command discretion. Alternatively reflective tape already applied may be masked with non reflective tape to reduce conspicuity when necessary.
