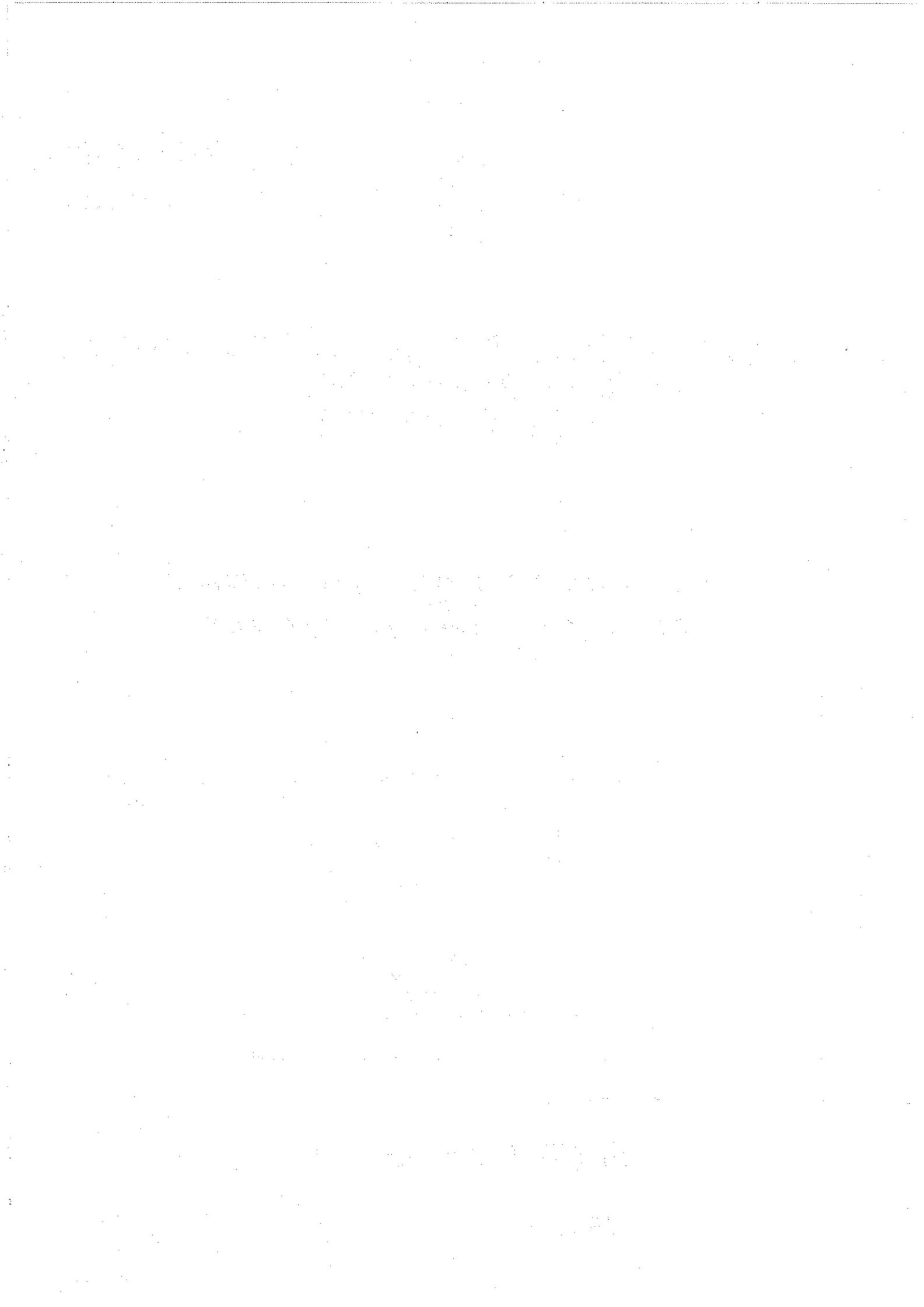

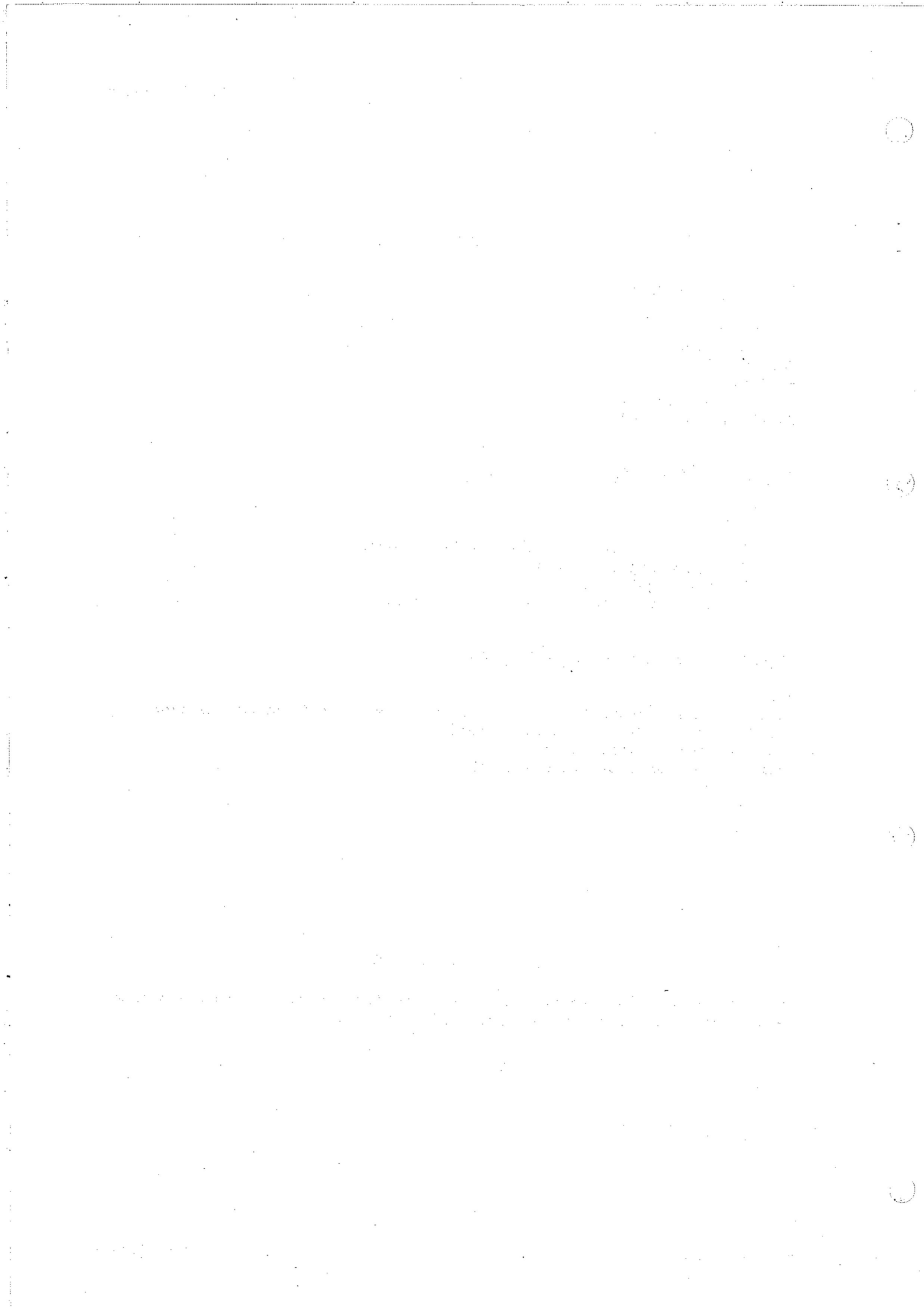

P R E F A C E

1 This publication contains Topic 1 and 2 information on the NBC intercom. unit. Topic 3 is issued separately. Because the intercom. unit is a simple, low-cost device, servicing is restricted to second line and there is no requirement for a Topic 4, 5 or 6. The bay servicing schedules normally contained in Topic 4 have been included in the present Topic 1.

▶ 2 The initial issue of Topic 1 described the NBC intercom. unit as originally introduced into service. Subsequently, a number of minor production changes were made by the manufacturer and Topic 1 has been amended to reflect these changes. Details of the variations between early and current units are given in Topic 2, GO leaflet No. 1. ◀

3 The subject matter of this publication may be affected by Defence Council Instructions or Special Technical Instructions. When this occurs, an amendment will normally be issued as soon as possible, but if discrepancies appear, the instruction is to be taken as the overriding authority.

4 Each page published with the initial issue bears the date of issue. Subsequent new or replacement leaves will be issued under the cover of an amendment instruction sheet, and will bear the number and date of that amendment. On all replacement pages, changes of technical import will be enclosed by indicator triangles, thus ▶.....◀, positioned outside the type area. When the content of a chapter, or of a table within a chapter, has been so changed as to make the use of indicator triangles impracticable, the amended chapter, or table, will carry the note "(Completely revised)" beneath the title.

The first part of the document deals with the general principles of the law of contract. It discusses the formation of a contract, the elements of a contract, and the consequences of breach of contract. The second part of the document deals with the law of tort, which is the law of civil wrongs. It discusses the elements of a tort, the defenses to a tort, and the remedies available for a tort.

The third part of the document deals with the law of property, which is the law of the right to use and dispose of things. It discusses the elements of a property right, the defenses to a property right, and the remedies available for a property right. The fourth part of the document deals with the law of succession, which is the law of the transfer of property upon death. It discusses the elements of a will, the defenses to a will, and the remedies available for a will.

The fifth part of the document deals with the law of trusts, which is the law of the arrangement by which one person transfers property to another person to hold for the benefit of a third person. It discusses the elements of a trust, the defenses to a trust, and the remedies available for a trust. The sixth part of the document deals with the law of insurance, which is the law of the contract by which one person transfers property to another person to hold for the benefit of a third person.

The seventh part of the document deals with the law of agency, which is the law of the relationship between a principal and an agent. It discusses the elements of an agency, the defenses to an agency, and the remedies available for an agency. The eighth part of the document deals with the law of partnership, which is the law of the relationship between two or more persons who have agreed to share in the profits and losses of a business. It discusses the elements of a partnership, the defenses to a partnership, and the remedies available for a partnership.

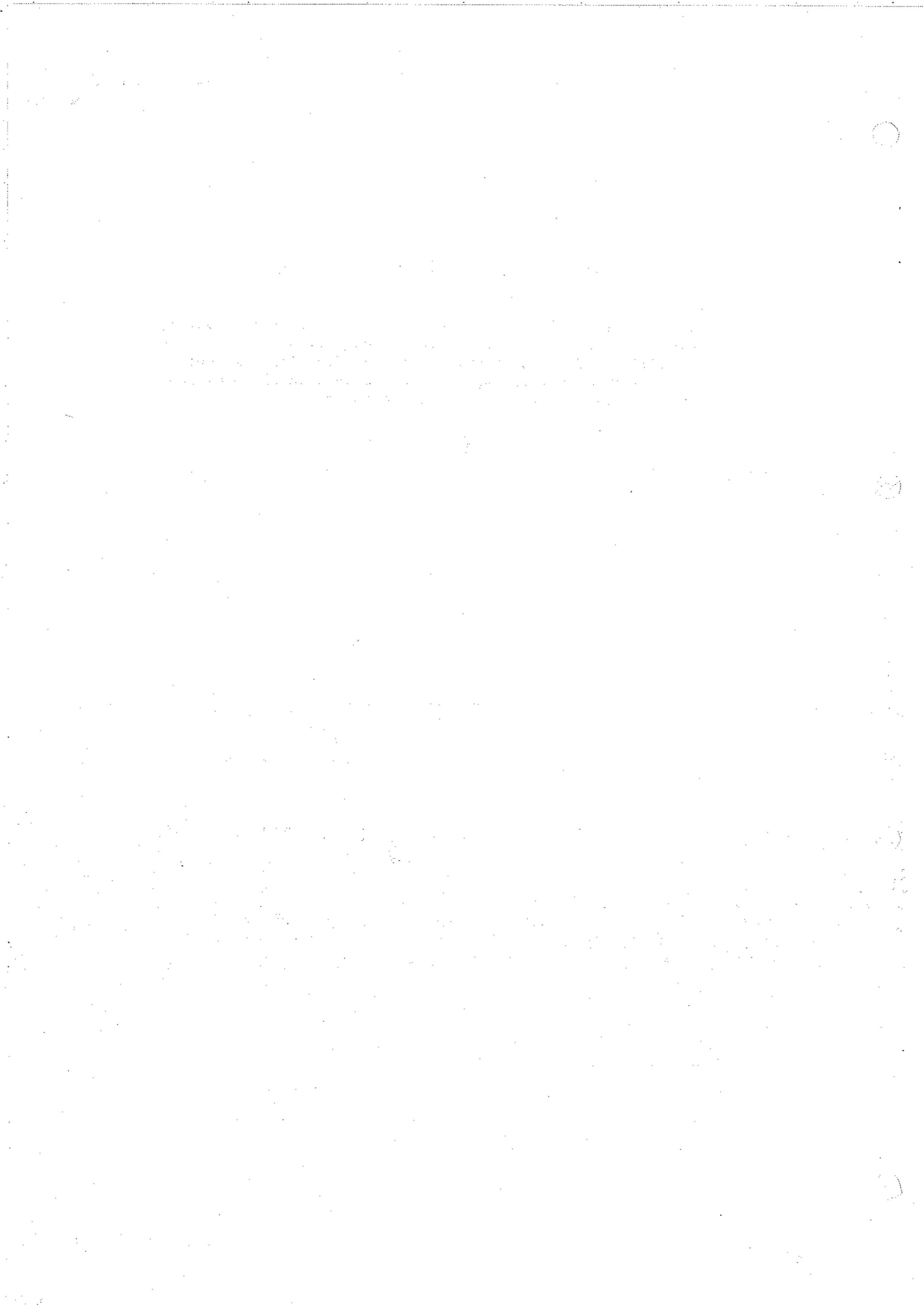
