Introduction

This Chapter contains a description of the various instruments installed in this aircraft, together with the necessary servicing information required to maintain the installation in an efficient condition. The Chapter is divided into a number of self-contained Groups of information, beginning with a general information Group covering the instrument installation as a whole and embodying installation details, general servicing, location of equipment and the removal of the

instrument panels. The remaining Groups each appertain to a particular collection of instruments as listed above. Each Group embodies a description of the installation of the instruments concerned, including the necessary servicing information and wiring diagrams of the electrically operated instruments. For a detailed description of the standard components employed, reference should be made to the appropriate Air Publications quoted in the following Groups.
