### Introduction

1. Pyrotechnics are included in the following equipment fitted to this aircraft:—

- (1) Ejection seat.
- (2) Fire extinguisher.
- (3) Engine turbo-starter.

### DESCRIPTION

#### Ejection seat

2. The ejection seat contains three cartridges. Reference should be made to A.P. 4288 Series for a detailed description of the seats and method of fitting the cartridges.

#### Fire extinguisher

3. The fire extinguisher is operated by an electrically fired cartridge unit. Reference should be made to Sect. 4 and to AP.957C for further information.

#### Engine turbo-starter

4. A cartridge operated turbo-starter is mounted on the front of the engine and contains three cartridges in its triple breech. Three spare cartridges are stowed in a carrier mounted on the lid of the starter access panel. For more detailed information on the turbo-starter reference should be made to A.P. 1181D.
