	(d) Tank structure.	(i) Clean internally and externally. (ii) Examine for damage and security of attachment to gun package.
	(e) Ammunition feed chutes.	(iii) Examine rubbing strips for damage. (i) Clean internally and externally.
	(f) Ammunition rollers.	(ii) Examine chutes and guides for damage. (i) Clean. (ii) Examine for damage. (iii) Lubricate bearings with oil, OX-14. (iv) Examine, by operation, for freedom of movement.
