PART I

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. AP 113 is the APFS catalogue. It lists the forms, air publications, joint service publications, air diagrams (except miniature air diagrams, which are merely reproductions of particular pages in listed APs), pamphlets, posters and other miscellaneous items that are stocked by APFS. It consists of four separately amended books:—

Book 1 — Forms

Book 2 — Uncoded APs and ADs, JSPs Inventories, Pamphlets, Posters, etc.

Book 3 — Uncoded Technical APs and ADs (Obsolescent)

Book 4 — Coded Technical APs, FAPs and ADs

The Code Group Notes in Book 4 are Based on AP100Z—0001. (Air Technical Publications Referencing System, Coding Lists and Procedures). APs and ADs not stocked by APFS because they have been produced mainly or exclusively for the Royal Navy are usually listed only in AP100Z—0201 (RN Catalogue of Air Publications and Diagrams), but are issued nevertheless by APFS to recognised customers.

2. The procedures for demanding, recording and maintaining items issued by APFS are contained in AP 113A (Regulations for the Supply and Maintenance of Publications and Forms).

3. Information affecting the contents of AP 113 is contained in the APFS Newsletter, which is normally issued weekly. RAF Forms 3113 may be used to record this information pending its incorporation in AP 113 by means of amendment list action. It is suggested that an RAF Form 3113 be placed at the end of each section or code group.

4. APFS invite notifications from holders of the catalogue as to errors, omissions and items overdue for deletion.
