

CHAPTER 7

RANGE COURSES

Introduction

1. Subject to certain age and classification qualifications cadets are eligible to fire the following categories of weapons:
 - a. Air Rifle
 - b. .22 in (Rimfire)
 - c. .303 in (Full Bore)
 - d. 7.62 mm (Self-Loading Rifle)
2. Eligibility and other factors governing firing of the various categories are contained in ACP 20A, ACTI No 31.

Air Rifle

3. All cadets, including probationers, are eligible to fire the air rifle subject to the observance of certain safeguards. These concern range construction, safety factors and the supervising of all range practices by adults aged 21 or over. Details of range construction and safety codes are contained in Manual of Shooting, ACP 18, Part III, Air Rifle Shooting. Air pistol firing is not authorized.

Ammunition

4. Ammunition, other than for the air rifle, is scaled for issue to each cadet on an annual basis.

Marksman Badges

5. Cadets are eligible to qualify for both ATC and RAF Marksman badges. Qualifying factors are detailed in the relevant annexes to ACP 20A, ACTI No 31.
