NOTE TO READERS

1. The modification numbers detailed at Sections 1 and 2 have been allocated in respect of the Vampire Airframe and Vampire Power Plant respectively, and the modifications classified up to the dates shown on sheets 1 of the relevant Sections.

2. It will be noted that the Airframe Mod. List begins with No.1 Modification. The modifications affecting the Power Plant also commence at No.1, but are prefixed by the letters "P.P." The modifications have been classified under the new classification system (A.M.O. A.100/52 refers) and are to be embodied in accordance with that system.

3. The space allotted under the column "Marks affected" is divided horizontally for each modification. A star in the top half denotes that the modification is applicable to the Mark shown at the head of that column, and the number in the bottom half indicates the leaflet number in the Vol.2, Part 1, of the relevant Air Publication.

4. Certain abbreviations appear in the Modification Lists where classifications are qualified by a particular aspect of the applicability. Those in common use are:-

C.W.P.	- Contractor's Working Party
N.C.P.	- No Contractor's Parts required
S.O.O.	- To Special Order only
R.P.O.	- Record Purpose only
comp.	- complementary
conc.	- concurrently
cons.	- consequential
emb.	- embodied
repr.	- on repair (of aircraft or component)
rplt.	- on replacement (of part affected)
supd.	- superseded
sup.	- supersedes

5. Amendments introduced by replacement leaves are indicated thereon by a vertical line in the left hand margin of the page against the matter amended or added since the replaced leaves were issued.
