## Introduction

The chapter is divided into a number of self-contained groups of information, beginning with a general information group covering the instrument installation as a whole and embodying installation details, general servicing, location of components and the removal of the

instrument panels. The remaining groups, each appertain to a particular collection of instruments as listed above. Each group embodies a description of the installation of the instruments concerned including the necessary servicing information and routing and theoretical diagrams of the electrically-operated instruments. For detailed information on the standard components employed, reference should be made to the appropriate Air Publications quoted in the following groups.
