

Appendix 1**FLYING CLOTHING**

1. The choice of flying clothing by crew members will depend on several factors. For instance, for a flight over the sea in winter, an immersion suit would be appropriate wear; for a flight over land in summer, a Mk. 2 flying suit may be more suitable. In the absence of general or local orders concerning the wearing of flying clothing, common sense will have to be used in deciding the items to be worn. Conditions under which the flight is to be made, and the possible emergencies which may be encountered, are factors to be considered when making the decision.

2. The life-jacket is worn over the flying or immersion suit. Details of flying clothing items are contained in A.P 1182E, Vol. 1.
