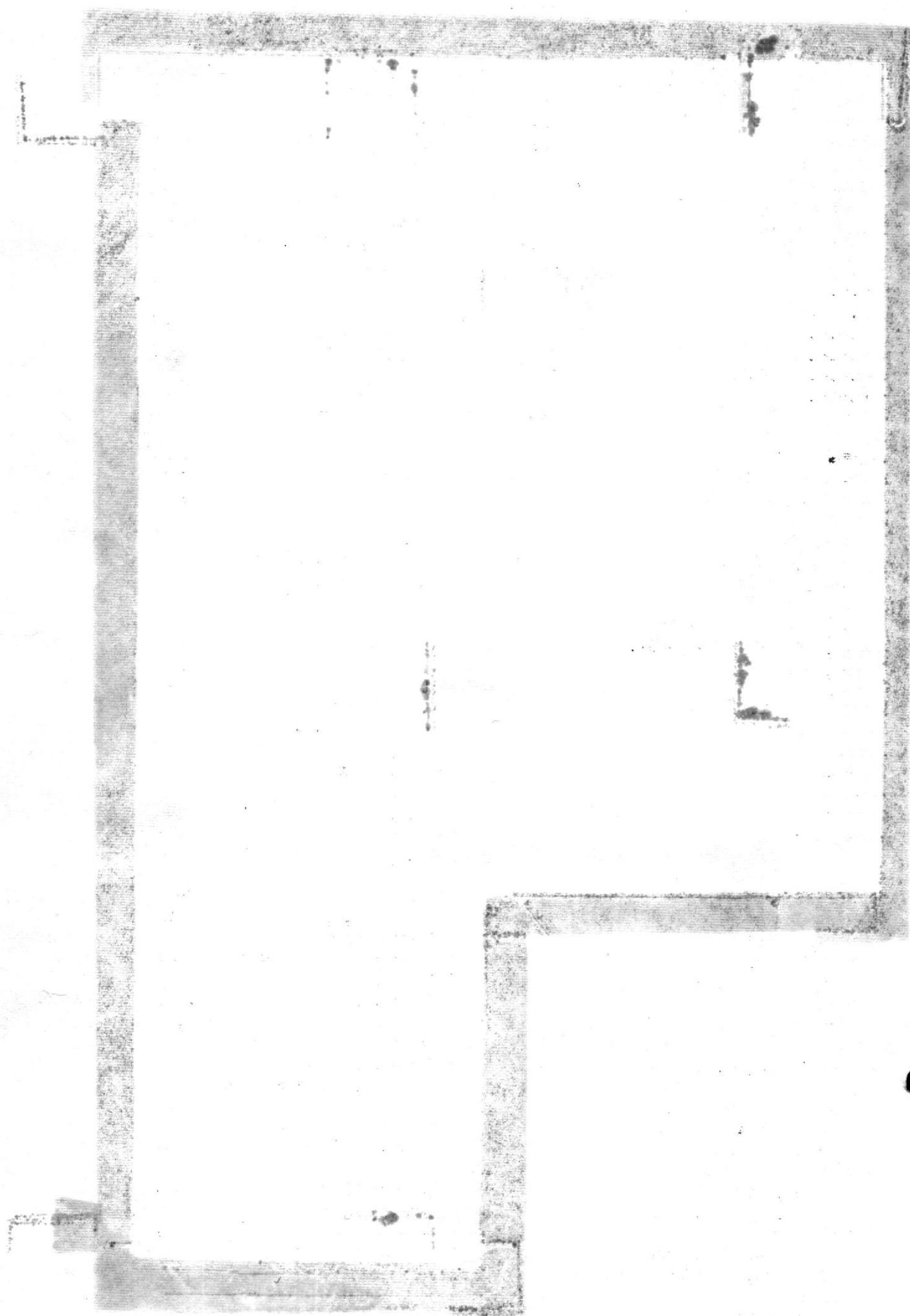

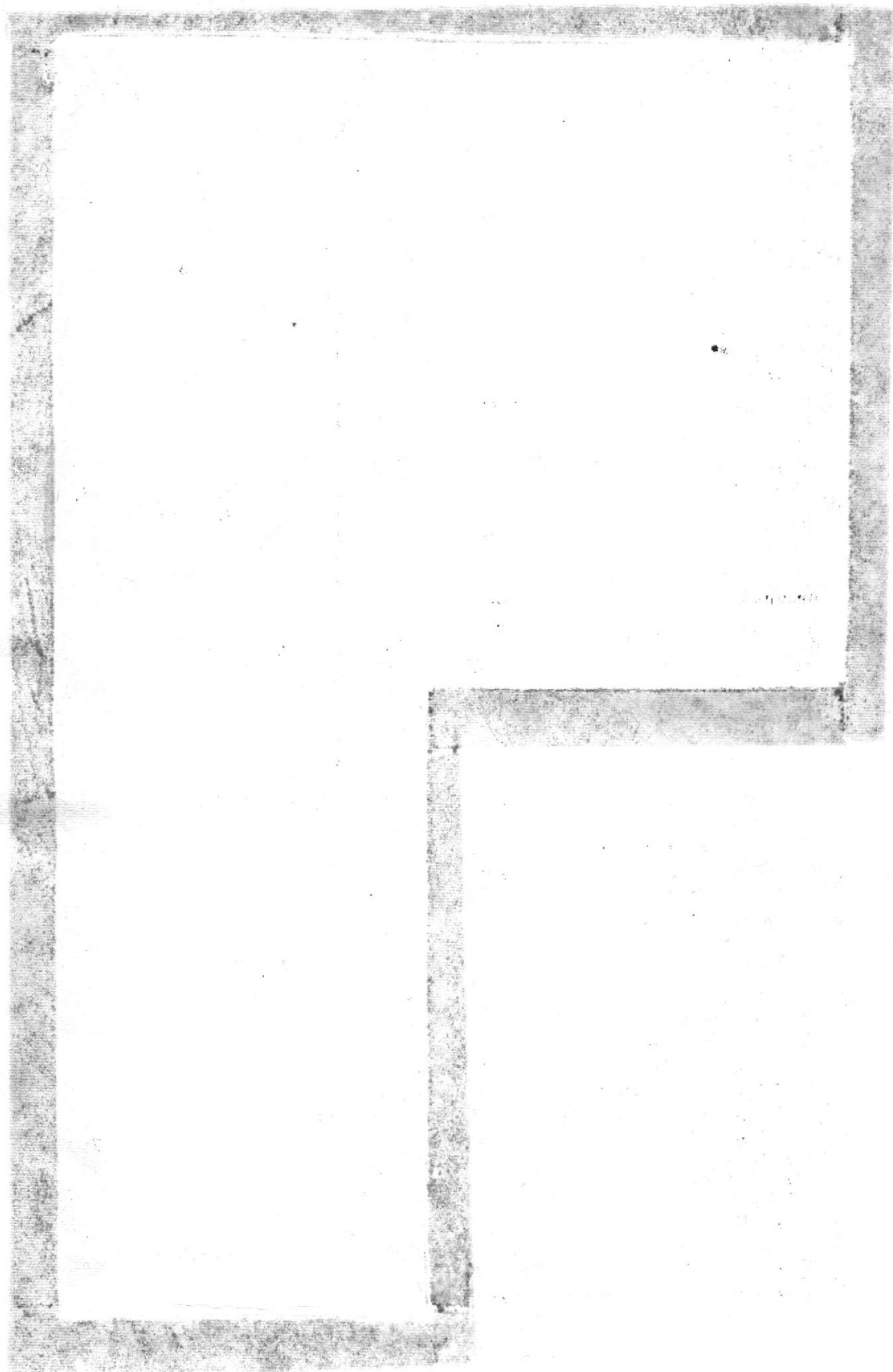


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Box, R.P. firing distribution 13	Bus-bars 20
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
