HELMETS, TYPE F AND TYPE G

Ref. No. 22C/1385 to 1388 and 22C/1725 to 1728



Use

For flying personnel as a general purpose helmet or as a head cover under a protective helmet. If used in static seats, a longer connector than that supplied may have to be made locally.


Details

The helmets are made from an open weave fabric and have a strap across the back to enable the fit round the neck to be adjusted. One earpiece contains a receiver in a rubber mould; the other is a soft leather pad. Back or side entries to the receiver may be used. The differences in the helmet are in the material of which they are made, that used for the Type G being more robust, and in the adjustment strap. On the Type F this is made from elastic; on the Type G the strap is non-elastic and is permanently attached to the head harness.
